

## CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

#### PHYSICIANS:

The Ohio State Medical Association (OSMA) is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians. The OSMA designates this live educational activity for a maximum of *4.0 AMA PRA Category 1™ credits*. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

#### **MEDICAL MARIJUANA:**

Physicians who attend 3E may earn **2.0 AMA PRA Category**  $1^{\text{TM}}$  credits that qualifies for the annual CME needed to maintain an Ohio Certificate to Recommend (CTR). An additional .5 credit may be earned by attending 2B.

#### **PAHCOM:**

Approved for **4.0 CEUs** from the Professional Association of Health Care Office Management (PAHCOM).

#### AAMA:

American Association of Medical Assistants (AAMA) CEUs submitted for **up to 4 CEUs**.

#### **OTHER CEUs:**

Through their reciprocity agreements, many licensing, credentialing and professional organizations accept courses and hour for hour credits from any provider who is ACCME accredited and awards *AMA PRA Category 1™ credit*. A sampling of those who accept this credit include AAPA, AAPC, ACMPE, AHIMA, Ohio Board of Nursing, and the State Medical Board of Ohio.
