Personal Statement

I have been involved in advocacy for OBGYNs and women's health for most of my career. I currently serve as the 2024 ACOG McCain advocacy fellow and ACOG delegate to OSMA. I have had the opportunity to advocate at the state and federal level through meetings with legislators and committee testimony. I regularly lecture on physician advocacy, reproductive justice and health equity to medical students, residents and attending physicians. I believe solving the physician burnout and moral injury problem requires systemic changes in medicine and we should address individual wellness through while working on those changes As the ACOG delegate to OSMA, I worked to increase our delegation size to 3 this year with hopes to expand further in 2025 and beyond. I believe when physicians build coalitions and work together, we can get the best outcomes for ourselves and the communities we serve. In 2023, I spent much of my spare time working with the Ohio Physicians for Reproductive Rights (OPRR) to advocate for passage of the Ohio Reproductive Rights Amendment. As a member of the OSMA delegation to AMA, I will continue to build relationships and assure the needs of Ohio's physicians and patients are represented. I would be honored to join the OSMA delegation to the AMA.
